122 PRIME CATTLE

A fantastic trade with numbers of finished cattle seemingly short nationally. Best butchers cattle continued their recent demand but with heavier wholesaling cattle much dearer by at least 15p/kg-20p/kg generally. Please continue to send cattle, we are desperately short of cattle for our regular clientele with another buyer anticipated coming next Tuesday.

Low steer entries saw a fantastic average of 220p/kg to a high of 239p/kg with the heaviest bullocks in short supply to £1441 in the lump.

Heavy females as dear as the handyweights today, selling to £1523 in the lump. Handy butchers beasts to 260p/kg on three occasions.

A massive uplift in the bull trade with best suckler bulls to 240p/kg on two occasions and heavy Charolais' to £1572. Black and whites were comparatively dearer selling with several passed 190p/kg to 197p/kg. More Bulls Urgently Needed!

5 COWS SOLD

A buoyant trade with values on the up at the moment. British Blue cows sold to 154p/kg at 668kg, with other blues to 140p/kg. A great result on the cows this week again. More Cows Needed Please!

An exceptional entry of lambs forward for the last sale in July. Numbers have been up all through the summer and trade this week perhaps the best yet!

Averaging 237p/kg or £95 a head and 39.7kg. With a top price of 267p/kg and £119 per head.

As expected this week, plenty of demand for lambs across all weights. Difficult to say which were easier to sell however 40kg Texels from Andrew Preece sold to 267p/kg, with his entry of 35 superb Texel lambs averaging 44kg and just shy of 250p/kg.

Lighter lambs to 256p/kg for 36kg from Roger Burgoyne with 20 pens 250p/kg or above.

Heavy lambs topped at £119.30 for 51kg from Sarah Levi, £119.20 for 47.5kg from Wayne Brown and 247p/kg.

Quality is what is required and that was certainly lacking this week. Name a hill breed and it was penned in Bridgnorth. The entry resembled an episode of Countryfile on Sunday afternoons.

Texels sold to £129, Suffolks £95 and mules to £85 with the leaner mules very well sold.

Hill ewes to £58 for Scotch Blackface, £46 for Swales, £68 for improved Welsh, £42 for Welsh Mountain, £39 for Speckles, £55 for Beulah and £60 for South Cheviots.

The very small plain ewe's difficult but larger plain ewes dearer than recent weeks.

Texel rams to £95 and small goats to £68.
