A trade to defy all trades – absolutely off the clock with several cattle hanging up well over 500p/kg deadweight. If your cattle were fit enough everything sold above expectations this morning and the best trade the auctioneer has experienced on heifers and steers.

One steer was over thirty months and sold to 232p/kg for 720kg (£1670.40).

Heifers sold on a supersonic trade selling past 300p/kg on three occasions to a top of 328p/kg, with handy weight heifers selling past £1700.

The bulls sold to a sharp trade also with best sucklers hitting 260p/kg with several others above 250p/kg. Black and Whites were generally a plain sample but still sold to 210p/kg.

2 cows sold to a high of 122p/kg for an Angus cross cow at 618kg (non-assured) with a well larded Charolais to 100p/kg for 802kg.

47 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 255P/KG

Early bird Andrew Bishop sold 3 super Limmie heifers to 328p/kg, 325p/kg and 311p/kg all just above the half ton mark, with his 530kg model adding up to £1722.50. Robin and Jan Edwards fliers sold to 298p/kg with their second to 295p/kg. Four of Richard Parkes sold to a high of 297p/kg for 516kg Limousin with the seven averaging 292p/kg! Andrew Dalton sold to 294p/kg and 292p/kg with Roger Rowson and the Digwood's both doing nicely to 290p/kg and 291p/kg.
