132 PRIME CATTLE

A few more cattle forward saw trade no faster with average not aided by more second quality sorts penned. Best butchers cattle were few and far between and sold to 246p/kg. Best quality steers sold well especially compared with deadweight prices for this week.

Bull trade was fairly lacklustre with buyers very choosy on their requirements. A large Holstein entry sold to realistic values with black and whites with meat in form demand. Suckler bulls sold to 200p/kg. Older heavy bulls saw trade less money as did very plain types.

14 COWS & 2 STOCK BULLS SOLD TO AVERAGE 85P/KG

Trade a little lower here also but not as depressed as the larger Monday centres!

Meat sucklers sold to 119p/kg for 680kg Limousins, with British Blue crosses to 116p/kg for 766kg. Meat slip Friesians sold to 101p/kg for 570kg. Plain boners harder to sell around the 40-45p/kg mark.

910kg Limousin bulls to 97.5p/kg with 1210kg Charolais to 85p/kg.

70 CLEAN CATTLE

Only 16 steers sold to av. 170p/kg – Two super Limousins from James Woolrich sold to 210p/kg and 207p/kg for 586kg and 590kg. 654kg Limousins from Phil Clarke sold to 194p/kg with handy weights Simmentals to 193p/kg for two from Charlie Sandells. Frank Millichamp sold Blondes to 191p/kg and 190p/kg. Bullocks over 36 months are included in the averages.

54 Heifers sold to average 177p/kg – 468kg Limousins from Steve Perkins sold to 246p/kg to head the day, with John Hewitt's Limmie selling to 236p/kg for 520kg, with 546kg Blondes to 234p/kg from Rob Hartley. Dave Chilton sold Limmies to 220p/kg and 219p/kg.

62 YOUNG BULLS OV. AV. 158P/KG

If your bulls were too big or too lean, trade was tricky but the right bulls sold reasonably well on the trade.

Steve Perkins' red shapey 588kg Limmie topped this section at 200p/kg, with 574kg British Blues to 199p/kg from Rob Hartley. 626kg Limousins sold to 196p/kg from Roger Tomley.

Friesians sold to 161p/kg from Dave Chilton with MRI bulls to 177p/kg and 176p/kg from David Thomas.
