Good numbers forward once again but a much more varied sample of cattle penned. Trade a little easier except on the better quality with handy-weight shop heifers in short supply. Our bull averages reflect a large sample of black and whites with only one suckler bull forward.

More steers saw a fair trade on the better end with well-finished types easiest sold, especially considering the reduced dead-weight quotations for this week! Handy-weights sold to 228p/kg with heavy steers to £1346.88.

Butchers heifers sold to 257p/kg with two others 240p/kg and 248p/kg. Few best shapes below 540kg today. More commercial clean cattle harder to place all round.

As previously mentioned, hardly any suckler bred bulls in the place! Best available sold to 190p/kg with Holstein Friesians to 174p/kg.

6 COWS SOLD TO A SIMILAR TRADE TO LAST WEEK with 888kg and 736kg Blue crosses selling to 130p/kg, with Charolais to 120p/kg for 760kg.

#### **101 CLEAN CATTLE**

**33** Steers sold to ov.av.165p/kg — Handy-weight Limmies from Mike Davies sold to 228p/kg for 500kg, with 644kg Limousins to 206p/kg from John Cantrill, with 732kg Simmentals to £1346.88. Plenty of over-agers and things best suited to the store ring helped to run averages down.

**68 Heifers sold to ov.av. 193p/kg** – A cracker from Richard Aston headlined today at 257p/kg for 462kg Limousins. Other handy-weight heifers sold to 248p/kg and 241p/kg from Richard Parkes and Forest Vale Growers respectively. Heavier females to £1285.28 for 554kg Limo from Richard Parkes.

Downward pressure on dead-weight prices this week with reduced numbers out nationally in livestock markets and dead-weight centres reporting longer waiting times to process sheep. But the market system still works! Trade on in spec hoggs would be a little firmer to 227p/kg and the overall trade within 2p/kg of last week, with only the very sheep showing a reduction in p/kg, but still adding up with plenty £90 to £100 and a top of £106.75 from Peter Levi.

Best hoggs creating plenty of trade, with Andrew Meredith taking top spot at 225p/kg to 227p/kg for 40kg and 45kg.

The trend on lighter weights continues with 35.5kg to 213p/kg Beltex and hill breeds 31.5kg to 198p/kg.
