#### **80 PRIME CATTLE**

There were several orders that wouldn't start today, with the cost of fuel prohibiting lorries running with unviable loads. A great trade from start to finish resulted, but with no guarantee this will bring more cattle to market next week. There were some well-finished beasts forward this morning, but with less quality than recent sales. Bull numbers were disastrously low but not surprising considering the uplift in feed costs. There are more bulls in the store sale on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> April, which may be a sign of things to come.

A small entry of steers that were mainly dairy bred sold to 250p/kg or £1670 in the lump. More fit steers needed next week please.

Heifers met a clear trade with five above or at 300p/kg to a high of 328p/kg. Heavy heifers were in strong demand and sold to £1785 in the lump, with those breaking up cattle seeing a sharper trade week-on-week.

Disappointing bull numbers, as already stated, saw sucklers selling to 250p/kg and £1610 in the lump – fewer heavyweights forward today. Black and white bulls saw strong demand, selling to 212p/kg with Hereford x Friesians to 225p/kg.

Two cows forward with many meat firms looking for OTM beef. 654kg Limmies sailed to 192p/kg or £1256 with plainer Herefords to 124p/kg for 638kg.
