With the hot weather helping to supress consumer demand, bull trade proved tricky whereas clean trade at least held its own. An overall average of 169p/kg resulted.

There were only a sprinkling of steers forward with most best suited as stores. Handy weight bullocks sold to 196p/kg with heavies to 194p/kg or just short of £1300 in the lump. A fair trade for butchers heifers selling to 230p/kg with several over 220p/kg.

A small bull entry proved difficult to place with the plainer, cheaper end finding more customers. Best Continentals sold to 174p/kg. Holsteins sold to 142p/kg.

Another easier trade however more spark than last week albeit at lower levels. The strong pound is adding around £10 per lamb in the Euro zone just on currency to the corresponding week last year.

This week's entry comprised of a large percentage of heavier lambs which sold well over 160p/kg to 180p/kg for 45.5kg Texels from AW Preece and export weights to a top price per kilo of 198p/kg for 41kg from Dave Sturgess.

Customers are looking for quality finished lean lambs and are willing to pay for meat with fed lambs realising around 10p/kg more than under-finished sheep.

Light weights to 179p/kg for 32.5kg Texels although hill lambs generally sold around 165p/kg.
