Fewer cattle, more buyers and a belting trade again. With good planting conditions and farmers busy in the fields, we were very short of cattle today. There was a fresh face to take numbers attending and he is back next week so please let us know your entries as soon as possible. 100 plus clean cattle will be needed, as well as many bulls and cows as we can get.

Some better quality bullocks forward today sold to 239p/kg, with heavy dairy bred steers to £1460. More steers and strong heifers will be required next week as the koshering trade springs back to life.

The heifer trade was a revelation with all heifers averaging 218p/kg including over-agers and Holsteins. Butchers heifers soared to 270p/kg. Heavy females sold to £1637 in the lump. More bidders for the bull entry today with all types with meat in fair demand. Best sucklers sold to 228p/kg. Holstein/Friesians with meat in strong demand to 171p/kg.

ONLY 8 COWS FORWARD

Increased buying support again. There is no point travelling your cows to other marts on this trade so please send before the trade slips this autumn. Best suckler crossbred British Blues sold to 158p/kg or £1292.44. Foreign cows more difficult to achieve satisfactory prices.

18 steers sold to av. 201p/kg – Shapey red Limousin 598kg from David Chilton topped this department at 239p/kg (£1429.22) closely followed by 476kg butchers bullocks from Ray & Marianne Bason at 238p/kg. Blonde crosses from Terrance Bebb added up nicely at £1460.96.

57 heifers sold to av. 218p/kg — A cracking red Limmie from David Preece took the headlines at 270p/kg for 482kg — a real result at £1301.40. Tony Barker took second spot at 258p/kg for 458kg. A super 688kg British Blue from Phil Clarke rang the bell at £1637.44, with Brian Wood dipping in his toe at £1481.76 for 686kg. A useful run of fed grass heifers for a "deserving cause" sold to 250p/kg on two occasions for handy Limousin cross.
