Prime Cattle Report (Red)

112 PRIME CATTLE

With most grass cattle either sold or not quite fit and housed inside, a vacuum of prime cattle has resulted. There were too few numbers of well-finished cattle to satisfy demand. Clean cattle were much dearer with our overall average depleted by the number of awkward bulls forward. A small sample of steers sold to 239p/kg for Simmentals, with well-finished bullocks in very short supply. Butchers heifers met a sharp trade to a high of 160p/kg for Limousins and several others above 250p/kg. Commercial heifers met very strong demand.

Bull trade remains "sticky" unless you have got exactly what buyers want! Bulls over 16 months and non FABBL are becoming much less valuable. There are many of these hitting the live auction at the moment and they are having to compete with low cow beef prices at this time. Handy weight Simmentals 12 months old sold to 226p/kg on two occasions.

40 COWS SOLD TO AV. 92P/KG

More cows forward as producers clear out for winter. There were very few meat cows forward this morning. Pete Raybould's useful run of meat Continentals sold to 139p/kg for two Limousins at 746kg and 720kg. British Blues sold to 130p/kg from Shirley Sutton. Meat Friesians sold to 119p/kg for Henry Yates. Lean steaking cows were generally 90-105p/kg, with boners from 60-87p/kg generally.

65 CLEAN CATTLE

7 steers sold to an overall average of 214p/kg. Rita Corfield sold her 598kg Simmental to 239p/kg to add up to £1429.22. A Limousin also from Lower Hill sold to 218p/kg for 570kg Limousin. 558kg Limousin sold to 214p/kg from Phil Roberts. Limousin steers a bit quick and lean sold to 205p/kg for 31 months from Hall Mill at 692kg (£1418.60).

58 heifers sold to an overall average of 218p/kg. A very dear trade was had headed by John Hewitt's Limousin heifers at 260p/kg and 257p/kg for 506kg and 526kg. Dave Chilton's decent run of 12 was headed by a handy 460kg British Blue at 259p/kg. Jean Kirkham sold Lims to 251p/kg and 259p/kg, with Peter Mitchell selling his last heifer to 252p/kg for 522kg. Hereford heifers to 115p/kg from Dave Chilton.

47 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 167P/KG

Vendors with well-finished bulls between 12 and 16 months of age, 600kg or below and possibly farm assured would leave reasonably satisfied with trade.

Charlie Sandells sold Simmentals to 226p/kg for 536kg and 494kg, with Limousins from Henry Yates to 221p/kg for 554kg. Friesians from Dave Evans sold to 196p/kg for 546kg. 576kg Friesians from the Yates stable once again sold to 183p/kg. MRI bulls sold to 190p/kg from Dave Thomas at 564kg.

John Hewitt sold 614kg Limousin to 209p/kg at 18 months and 206p/kg for similar weights at 19 and 20 months old.

Generally speaking, bulls over 16 months of age are depreciated by 5-15p/kg and worse if too lean!
