Improved numbers which was great to see, with best cattle seeing a jump in values, whereas more commercial sorts holding their own. Handyweight shop cattle especially dear. Extra buying support for well finished heifers in operation today.

Some well meated bullocks penned this morning selling to 191p/kg or £1295 in the lump. A cracking trade on butchers heifers, with 4 above 250p/kg to a high of 258p/kg. Heavy heifers sold to just short of £1400.

Bull trade pretty lack lustre, with plenty of bulls in the pipeline at the moment and with bull meat having to compete with increased supplies of cow beef and imports. Best bulls sold to 206p/kg, with heavies to £1301 in the lump.

A solitary heavy Hereford cow traditionally meated sold to 88p/kg for 926kg.

Some meaty steers forward today saw John Cantrill selling to 191p/kg for 634kg, with 3 Charolais crosses to 185p/kg at around 700kg from Mrs 'B'. Blondes at 680kg sold to 180p/kg from Frank Millichamp. More handier weights steers required.

77 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 208P/KG

A superb run from Richard Parkes sold to 258p/kg, 256p/kg and 254p/kg for 452kg to 500kg with 528kg Limmies to 251p/kg from Matt & Wendy Bower. Roger Jordin sold to 242p/kg for 528kg, with Mark Jones selling to 242p/kg at 530kg at the death for his blondes. Limousins sold to 240p/kg + 241p/kg for David Digwood. Heavy blondes sold to £1397.50 for a 'deserving cause' at 650kg.

Trade considerably dearer, with a very respectable overall market average of 184p/kg, with a top price of 230p/kg and £103 per head.

Richard Morgan's lambs 44kg topped the sale at 230p/kg and £103 for 51.5kg with consignment averaging 49p/kg and 209p/kg.

All the best butchers lambs well over £2 per kilo, with a number of sheep over 50kg, trading at over £100 per head.

Commercial export spec lambs showing the biggest lift, plenty at 180p/kg. Lighter types to 183p/kg for 33kg from Rob Rose and welsh hill lambs to 178p/kg for 35kg - £62.30 per head.
