A real "bite" in the trade today with evidence of some seasonal demand aided by the colder weather. All sections and commodities saw an upturn in values, with best quality sorts selling "like hot cakes" from start to finish.

More steers penned this morning but few well-finished, next quality sorts. Angus steers sold to 220p/kg or £1421 in the lump. Second quality bullocks saw strong demand whether assured or otherwise.

The butchers heifer trade was exceptional today and although there was not a major headline beast, a lot of cattle sold well above expectation. Half tonnes heifers sold to 244p/kg with heavies to 143p/kg or just below £1500.

With bulls in shorter supply at the moment, vendors need to take advantage of this trade but your bulls need to be fit. British Blues and Limmies sold to 211p/kg, with Friesians to 180p/kg.

MORE BULLS REQUIRED FOR NEXT WEEK PLEASE

20 COWS SOLD TO AVERAGE 98P/KG More forward and a firm trade with three buyers attending. Only ultra-fat, non-assured cows found trade "sticky", with all other cows easily sold. Limousin cross cows sold to 135p/kg for 736kg, with three others passed 130p/kg. Angus stock bulls 884kg sold to 102p/kg.

87 heifers sold to av. 212p/kg – 496kg and 518kg Limmies from the Jordin boys sold to 244p/kg and 240p/kg respectively to seal the day. 582kg British Blues from IGC Morris sold to 243p/kg to add up nicely to £1414 but with his Limousin to £1455.18. Handier weights (x2) sold to 243p/kg also, both from the Raybould stable with Andrew Craig (x£) selling to 242p/kg.

45 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 174P/KG


