A much better entry of lambs forward for the Christmas fatstock judged this year by Angus Mutch and a `new' Brian Meredith cup. The George King cup for the Champion Pen was awarded this year to Pete Morris for 42kg Beltex lambs, realising 550p/kg and sold to Adil Choudhery on behalf of Pak Mecca Meats, Birmingham.

1<sup>st</sup> prize lambs under 40kg also awarded to Pete Morris for 37kg Beltex lambs purchased by local Bridgnorth butcher, Keith Alderson for Charlie Spencer, who also purchased the Champion Single Lamb 528p/kg, a 45kg Beltex showed by Lee Preece.

Trade throughout the sale was very brisk, with all the 1<sup>st</sup> prize lambs over 500p/kg. 2<sup>nd</sup> prizes around 400p/kg and several pens of lambs, with no cards, around 300p/kg. A market average of 263p/kg with commercial lambs to 294p/kg outside of the show for 46.5kg Texels from Richard Morgan. Heavier lambs sold to 285p/kg for Dutch Spotted x lambs at 48kg from Sarah Levi. Lambs under 40kg a firmer trade with customers keen to buy a lighter lamb.

The first time for some weeks the market average was just shy of the £100 mark and Texel ewes sold to £200 from Stuart Moss. The overall average would be a reflection of the quality of ewes, plenty of strong ewes penned with customers keen to purchase quality and weight. Suffolk ewes much dearer with the top end, just over £140 and Mules nowhere near as strong as last week selling to £105. Strong, but lean ewes remain well sold, however absolute crackers selling at a similar level to recent weeks. Hill ewes to £76, improved Welsh and Welsh £50 and plain kippers £31.

Rams sold to £150 from P Skellern, Dutch Spotties and Texels £140 from JC Taylor. Three boer goats sold to £82 for small, young goats.
