Some tidy steers forward sold to 222p/kg or £1420.80 in the lump. Steers that were well finished and not too big, easier to sell.

Butchers heifers were a firm trade throughout without any real humdingers this morning, selling to a high of 245p/kg with plenty in the 240 and 230 pence's. Heavy females to £1332.38. Bulls were a little on the lean side today, but well-finished sorts sold well with Continentals to 209p/kg. Black and whites held firm selling to 171p/kg and easier sold then second quality Continentals.

4 cows forward saw lean but meated Blonde cows at 860kg selling to 155p/kg (£1333), with leaner Saler crosses to 134p/kg for 732kg (£980).
