Less cattle forward as anticipated following an easing in beef values last week and a short Bank Holiday week ahead. Cattle were more money with the best especially so – all buyers will be back next week so more numbers will be required to satisfy regular orders.

A good show of steers with several Holsteins sprinkled in. Best quality sold to 221p/kg with heavies just short of £1400 and were more than in line with dead-weight quotes for the week. Handy-weight butchers heifers topped at 254p/kg with several past 230p/kg. Commercial breakers a sharp trade with buyers leaving short of these.

Bulls at least as dear as recent sales, with some good sorts penned. Sucklers sold to 210p/kg with heavies just short of £1400. Black and white bulls a very sharp trade to 175p/kg and more of these are required for next Tuesday.

9 COWS SOLD TO OV. AV. 130P/KG

A flying cow trade again selling to 168p/kg for 706kg Angus with Limousins to 150p/kg at 662kg. 840kg Devons to £1243 in the lump. Holsteins were not the best today but sold to 130p/kg and 125p/kg with meat.

56 CLEAN CATTLE

29 Steers sold to ov.av 181p/kg – More steers than heifers forward saw 520kg Blues from Matt Bower (having barely recovered from their weekend wedding exploits!) selling to 221p/kg with 626kg Lims to 215p/kg also helping to ease their headache. 658kg Blondes from Frank Millichamp sold to 212p/kg with 566kg Charolais to 208p/kg from John Johnstone. The Baylis' sold Friesians to 176p/kg at 482kg and we hope to see them back.

27 Heifers sold to ov.av. 210p/kg – Too few females on this occasion saw a nice run from Richard Parkes hitting the headlines at 254p/kg for 482kg with others to 245p/kg, 239p/kg and 237p/kg (x2). 538kg Blondes sold to 232p/kg from Frank Millichamp. Todd Harris' Limousins sold to 236p/kg for 452kg. More heifers required next week please.

42 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 186P/KG

572kg Limousins from Robert Pugh took the top spot at 210p/kg, with Mr Sandells 562kg to 206p/kg. Heavy, but lively, Limmies from Dave Preece sold to 200p/kg for 660kg with 714kg Blondes to 194p/kg from Howard Mold (£1385.16). Hereford crosses to 192p/kg from Rob Ball. Friesians sold well to 175p/kg for Henry Yates, with Colin Evans selling to 174p/kg. 50 plus bulls needed next Tuesday please.
