190 PRIME CATTLE

A few more cattle forward on a very hot market day, also saw trade warming up further. Averages wouldn't look quite as high as last week but there were many more ordinary types forward. As usual there were plenty of buyers for all shapes and sizes, ages and assurance.

Our steer entry was more plentiful but mixed in type, with plenty of overage Holsteins, etc forward. Best quality met dealer returns to highs of 214p/kg and to £1409.28 in the lump.

Lots of customers for butchers heifers, with a new face around the ring. Handy weights sold up to 246p/kg with many above 230p/kg. Heavy heifers were not the best but still sold to £1285.20.

Bull numbers were good again, but perhaps without the shape of last week generally. Heavy sucklers sold to 214p/kg with plenty over 200p/kg, with Continental bulls selling to £1437.36. A very tidy trade on meated Friesians sold to 184p/kg.

10 COWS & 3 STOCK BULLS

Trade very good here with 3 buyers present but only 2 purchased.

734kg Limousin topped at 159p/kg from Mr Sandells, with 568kg Simmental slips to 147p/kg from Tim Madeley. 1008kg Blonde stock bull to 120p/kg from Charlie Cadwallader.

Many more cows and stock bulls are needed with strong buying support guaranteed.

112 CLEAN CATTLE

38 steers sold to av. 187p/kg – Handy Limousins from John Johnston Farms headed this department at 214p/kg, with Gerald Kincaid's useful run selling to 210p/kg, with Philip Terry also selling to 210p/kg. 542kg sold to 209p/kg from Derek Pugh. Overage Friesians to 161p/kg from the Boden family.

74 heifers sold to average 194p/kg – A nice run from Richard Parkes topped at 246p/kg, with 3 others 240p/kg or above. Matt Bower and Brian Watkins both hit 235p/kg. Roger Jordin, Stuart Bebb and Dave Chilton all sold 230p/kg or more. Second quality heifers generally more money unless very fat.

78 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 171P/KG

Good entries but with quality more varied but a sharp trade resulted. 634kg Limousins from Glyn Breeze took the headlines at 214p/kg, with Stuart Bebb's 678kg Limousin X to 212p/kg. Handier weights from Charlie Sandells sold to 210p/kg. Friesians and other dairy bulls looked well and sold against the suckler types, with John Cantrill selling to 184p/kg and 176p/kg, with David Evans to 173p/kg. With feed prices a little cheaper, these seem to be stacking up quite well.
