An improved number penned this morning which helped filling regular orders. Trade fairly lethargic with best quality, wellfinished clean cattle that were not too big easiest placed. Bull trade is simply bottomless and is suffering the effect of cheap imported product which continues to undermine beef values.

A handful of quality steers forward which sold to 219p/kg or £1392 in the lump.

Butchers heifers in strong demand again selling to 255p/kg with two others 250p/kg or more. Heavy females sold to £1377.20.

It is proving difficult to get orders for bulls at the present - never mind the price. Best sucklers sold to 190p/kg, with heavy sucklers over £1300 on two occasions. Black and whites sold to 148p/kg.

<u>3 COWS</u> forward sold to a fair trade with cows easier sold than bottom end clean and/or bulls. No best types forward saw Blondes selling to 116p/kg for 758kg.

## 77 CLEAN CATTLE

**13 Steers sold to ov.av.167p/kg** – Tremendous shapes from Mr May sold to 219p/kg for 636kg Limousins closely followed by handy-weight Lims to 217p/kg from Mrs B. Hereford bullocks sold to 171p/kg from Andrew Maiden at 566kg.

**64 Heifers sold to ov.av. 193p/kg** – Storming Lims from Jan Edwards sailed away to 255p/kg for 506kg, with her 528kg model to 250p/kg. Richard Parkes' normal quality sold to 251p/kg for 484kg, with others 244p/kg to 248p/kg. Richard Morgan sold 626kg Limousins to £1377.20.

## 48 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 159P/KG

Bull trade was average at best today with bull beef struggling to sell unless they are dirt cheap!

Howard & Colin Fish took top spot at 190p/kg for 480kg, with another to 187p/kg. Other handyish weights (512kg) sold to 186p/kg, with 620kg Lims to the same from "Birthday Boy" Henry Yates.

Friesians sold to 148p/kg from Colin Evans. Black and whites easier sold than the better end bulls generally.
