A small Bank Holiday week entry was disappointing considering last week's trade – barely enough to get regular order started! A very good trade throughout and double the numbers will be needed next week with summer Bank Holidays out of the way until next year.

A disastrously low entry of steers saw dairy bred Simmentals to 181p/kg or £1227.18 in the lump.

Butchers heifers were generally on the heavier side this week and sold to 239p/kg on two occasions with heavy females to £1408.

Reasonable bull numbers saw an improved trade with well-finished sorts rewarded. Shop bulls sold to 221p/kg, with black and white bulls to 178p/kg.

ONLY 3 COWS forward saw Longhorns to 118p/kg and lean steaking Holsteins to 105p/kg.

Only 3 steers sold to average 161p/kg – Simmentals sold to 181p/kg for 678kg from Terry Bebb. Over-age, 50m, non-assured Limousins on the lean side helping to reduce averages!

37 heifers sold to av. 214p/kg – A cracking trade here with 560kg Limousins from Roger Jordin selling to 239p/kg, with 522kg Lims to the same for a “deserving cause”. 464kg Limousins to 237p/kg from Peter Raybould with heavies to £1408.32 for 652kg from Matt & Wendy Bower.

Shapely Continentals building up to be as dear as they have been for some weeks to 214p/kg for 38.5kg from Roger Williams and £103 for 54.5kg at 189p/kg for Peter Levi. All lambs over 52kg averaged £100.40, with 42kg lambs to 204p/kg and 44kg to 210p/kg.

On Saturday 27th August, Nock Deighton Agricultural LLP held the eighth annual sale on behalf of Downton Estates at The Brakes Farm.

Another early start for those involved in sorting and penning 5,500 lambs, the entire lamb crop of 2016, no easy task with three sheep races at full pace in the moonlight!

2940 wether lambs attracted interest from far and wide, with customers from all four corners of England and Wales, sold to an average of £64.20 to £70.50 for Suffolk x Mules and £69 for Texel x Mules, with very few under £60, even the last pen at £51.50.

2610 ewe lambs averaged £70 to £86 for New Zealand sired Suffolk x Mules with small running lambs around £65.

Texels to £79 and again all over £60 despite several pens of mini ewe lambs.
