44 PRIME CATTLE

Not enough cattle to start regular orders. A sharp trade on butchers' cattle, however, with more commercial cattle holding their own.

The marketplace is very tricky at the moment with nobody in the chain of events having an easy ride – including auctioneers! This was the smallest entry of cattle since the auctioneer began selling in 2002!

A sprinkling of steers fold to 291p/kg or just short of £1900 in the lump.

Butchers' heifers topped at 313p/kg with £1682 top call per head. Seven cattle sold at 300p/kg and above.

Bull trade seems very volatile at the moment with averages down in all the Monday markets. Heavy bulls still sold to 247p/kg or £1834 in the lump. Dairy bulls sold to 209p/kg.

25 CLEAN CATTLE

7 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 226P/KG

Evans (Curdale) topped here at 291p/kg for a 652kg Limmie, with black Limousins to 234p/kg for 698kg from Dave & John Preece. Grass steers sold to 211p/kg for Simmentals and Herefords from Phil Terry.

18 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 291P/KG

A worthwhile trip from Mrs B who sold her first at 302p/kg then reached a high of 313p/kg, all around 500kg. Evans (Curdale) and Richard Parkes took joint second at 309p/kg for 520kg and 538kg respectively. 510kg Lims from Gilbert Brown sold nicely to 307p/kg. 580kg Lims sold to £1682, again from the Parkes stable.

19 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 212P/KG

Richard Bebb sold their run to 247p/kg for 744kg Limmies, with Dave Preece selling his single to 246p/kg for 652kg. Norwegian Reds sold to 209p/kg from Bob Mayer for 612kg.

A smaller Bank Holiday entry of lambs and quality was quite mixed. As in recent weeks, meat was selling easily and lean, under-finished lambs were not so keenly sought after.

Best butchers' lambs sold to 275p/kg for the top pen of Texel lambs from Evans, The Day House and heavier lambs to £139 for 61kg lambs from Burwarton Estates. Generally, lambs over 48kg sold easily. Suffolk-sired lambs sold to £134.50 with heavier lambs averaging £128.50. Very few lambs under 40kg, which sold to 242p/kg for 38kg, with plenty of demand for lighter weights.
