A much improved number especially in the bull section. Averages purvey a very mixed sample penned this morning and not necessarily a lesser trade. Best quality were easiest sold, with older, grassy sorts still finding punters but only to a certain level!

A nice show of butchers heifers sold to 248p/kg with ten others 240p/kg or above. Heavy females to £1336.

The largest bull entry for a week or two showed a deficit of best sorts with a very strong Holstein contingent including over thirty months. Continentals sold to 209p/kg on two occasions and to £1503. Black and whites sold to 174p/kg.

ONLY 2 COWS sold to a similar trade with Blonde cross cows to 98p/kg for 682kg and Simmentals (non-assured) to 80p/kg for 808kg.

66 CLEAN CATTLE

Only 5 Steers sold to ov.av. 170p/kg - Hereford crosses from Frank Davies topped at 178p/kg for 714kg, with 468kg Angus to 176p/kg from Max Ossig. More steers needed for our regular buyers.
