Very good numbers forward this morning and with wholesalers and butchers requiring meat supplies for Christmas, a firm trade resulted from start to finish. There were more heifers penned, but no more if as many best quality butchers' types so the best of these saw a firming picture. A great entry of bulls reflected the "apprentice" last week making a top job, although I am advised they might have been dearer today! Impossible I hear you say!

Only a small sprinkling of steers saw a few best types and a top call of 259p/kg resulted in £1585.08 in the lump.

Five heifers sold about 300p/kg for a record high so far this year of 329p/kg! More heavier, well-fleshed finds sold nicely to £1785 in the lump with eight £1700 or more.

A good day in the bull department with cattle here as dear as the auctioneer can remember. Best continental bulls sailed to 277p/kg with three great heavier bulls passed £2000 to £2088. Black and white trade was a revelation with most passed 200p/kg. 228p/kg was top price per kilo on Holsteins.

Seven cows forward sold to a firm level of trade to 161p/kg for 724kg Limousin cow or £116.84 in the lump. 806kg Angus cows sold to 129p/kg or £1039.74. More cows required in the forthcoming week or two. Do not leave it too late if you need to shift them before Christmas!

ONLY 8 STEERS SOLD TO OVERALL AVERAGE 213P/KG

Little best quality forward in the steer department saw David and Paul Chilton sell their Charolais cross to 259p/kg for 612kg, £1585.00. Saler crosses from David and John Preece sold to 230p/kg and 226p/kg for 678 and 640 kg respectively. Blues from Philip Terry sold to 214p/kg for 640kg.

89 HEIFERS SOLD TO OVERALL AVERAGE 259P/KG

Evans (Curdale) held the top ground once again selling Blues and Limmies just over half a tonne to 329p/kg and 327p/kg. Jan and Robin Edwards were last in, but sold their 544kg model to 328p/kg or £1784.32. Lightening struck again for Evan Watkins selling his best to 321p/kg for 524kg. Heavier 570kg Limousins from Rob Morris also met the 300p/kg barrier or £1710 in the lump. Gary and Greg Thomas' red Limmie added up nicely to £1777.84 for 626kg.

A stunner of a Limousin from Rob Morris took the headlines at 277p/kg for 576kg, with IGC Morris' best limo to 268p/kg for 574kg with others to 263p/kg and 260p/kg from the same stable. Heavy bulls saw strong demand, with Limousins to 260p/kg for 796kg from Will and Jackie Forrester for £2020 in the lump, which was just pipped by Pete Kirton's 842kg model at £2088.

As previously stated, a fantastic black and white sale saw Dave and John Preece selling to 228p/kg with the Beaumonts selling to 224p/kg and Dickie Price selling to 222p/kg.
