112 PRIME CATTLE

Considering we are in January, the trade is holding up well at the moment. There was a ring full of buyers today and we were genuinely short of cattle with buyers leaving short of viable loads. An exceptional trade on any cattle with meat and shape. Cattle that were lean and had for belly saw trade similar to recent sales.

A sprinkling of steers forward with very limited quality saw Limousins to 209p/kg and more decent bullocks are required each week.

Heifer trade was sparkling on retail cattle with more cattle 240p/kg or above to a high of 248p/kg on two cattle. Cattle were a credit to producers today.

We need more well-finished bulls at the moment with eight bidders for 38 bulls. A fiery trade with best sorts more money and black and whites just as dear as recent sales. Best Continentals sold to 227p/kg with heavies just short of £1500.

ONLY 3 COWS met a flier of a trade with meat Holstein cows from John Rogers selling to 126p/kg for 850kg, with British Blue crosses to 140p/kg from Brian Watkins. Why go elsewhere when you are getting more locally? Three buyers needing cows and stock bulls each week.

74 CLEAN CATTLE

Only 10 steers sold to average 181p/kg – A 600kg British Blue cross steer from David Chilton topped at 209p/kg, with Charolais from Mrs Burgoyne to 199p/kg and 198p/kg. Handy 544kg Limousins from Brian and David Whiteman closely followed at 197p/kg. More well-finished steers needed whatever the shape.

64 heifers sold to av. 209p/kg – Two Blondes from IGC Morris stole the honours in a very good sample of butchers beats at 248p/kg (x2) both around half a tonne. Tom and Tony Barker's Limmies sold to 247p/kg, with Richard Parkes' run selling to 246p/kg to average 239p/kg on ten! Brian Watkins sold to 245p/kg, with Roger Jordin selling three to 244p/kg. Andrew Meredith sold 582kg Limmies to £1368.

38 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 181P/KG

A super Blonde from Bill Yeomans headed this department at 227p/kg for 566kg, with 516kg Limmies to 222p/kg from IGC Morris. Limmies from Billy Winterburn sold to 220p/kg for 488kg, with heavies 702kg to 211p/kg from Todd Harris (£1481.72).

Friesians to 168p/kg from Charlie Lloyd with Ed Green selling his black and whites to 166p/kg.
