#### **168 PRIME CATTLE**

Good entries of clean cattle once again as bull numbers are still difficult to find. With retailers reporting slow demand and dead weight centres taking another cut out of their quotations for the week, an easier trade resulted but with best handy weight cattle easiest sold. Our overall market average of 182p/kg included a strong Holstein influence in the bulls and several cattle 30-48 months.

A fair entry of steers with many lean enough and/or over weight. Best butchers steers sold to 230p/kg, with over-age heavies to £1465.40.

Butchers heifers saw strong demand selling to 247p/kg with several above 230p/kg. Heavy females topped at £1322.40.

Bull trade was generally good and more bulls would have easily found homes at satisfactory prices on the trade. Handyweight bulls sold to 224p/kg, with dairy bulls adding up well to £1064.

#### 18 COWS SOLD TO OV. AV. 102P/KG

Almost all black and whites penned this morning, some with meat and others with little!

Hereford crosses sold to 119p/kg from Richard Hartley, with Gareth Jones' 910kg and 758kg Holsteins with meat selling to 117p/kg. James Tudor's Holsteins stacked up well to a high of £1158.

#### **MORE COWS & STOCK BULLS NEEDED**

#### **130 CLEAN CATTLE**

37 Steers sold to av. 178p/kg – A lack-lustre trade especially if bullocks were not in spec. Butchers bullocks 516kg sold to 230p/kg Limousins for a "very deserving cause", closely followed by 568kg Limousin from Gordon Jones at 222p/kg. Dave Bibbey sold 34m Limousin crosses to £1465 and £1372 with Simmentals to £1380 from Ian & Richard Preece.

93 Heifers sold to av. 189p/kg – Trade was firm on the better end, with "off centre" sorts more difficult. 484kg Limousins from Marianne Bason stole the headlines at 247p/kg, with Richard Parkes' run of seven selling to 238p/kg. Matt Bower and Stuart Bebb sold to 236p/kg and 235p/kg respectively. 580kg Limousins made most in the lump at £1322, again from Kytes Nest.

Only 38 Bulls sold to av. 170p/kg — Well-fleshed bulls saw a decent trade once again and more are needed to fulfil regular orders. Handy-weight Limousins from Frank Povall sold to 224p/kg and 216p/kg, with Brian Watkins' Blondes to 214p/kg (x2). A firm market for fleshed Holsteins saw Harold Pugh selling to 174p/kg, just pipped by Colin Evans at 175p/kg, with Bill Rodenhurst's Montbeliarde to 181p/kg.
