BRIDGNORTH LIVESTOCK MARKET WEEKLY REPORT – 31.05.16



79 PRIME CATTLE

A small Bank Holiday week entry saw an improved trade all through, with many buyers leaving empty-handed with not enough cattle to get started. A full buyer contingent is anticipated next week and so more cattle will be needed to satisfy improved demand.

Our bullock entry was very mixed with many 36-55 month Holstein bred – these sold to £1343, with non-FABBL Continentals to 210p/kg.

A sharp trade on butchers heifers saw 240p/kg achieved on three occasions, with a high of 242p/kg. Females sold to \pm 1323 on the lump.

Not a bad show of bulls also met a sharper market, with best quality Continentals to 215p/kg and heavy bulls to £1239.50. Heavy old Holsteins to £1155.08.

14 COWS SOLD TO AV. 92P/KG - with most cows of the boner variety and not Farm Assured but there was a new face around the ring for them. Limousin cows with meat sold well to 148p/kg and 142p/kg. Most other cows forward would have well suited turning out on some good grass.

40 CLEAN CATTLE

Only 17 steers sold to av. 150p/kg – Our average was decimated by heavy over-age Holstein bullocks selling above expectations passed £1300 on three occasions from DC Bibbey & Sons, with Mr Withers selling 618kg Limousins to 210p/kg and 542kg from IGC Morris to 195p/kg. 54p/kg "specials" were also included here.

Only 23 heifers sold to av. 205p/kg – A super trade with 488kg Limousins topping for Matt Bower at 242p/kg. 528kg Limousins sold to 240p/kg from Simon Jones. Mrs Edwards travelled from afar to achieve 240p/kg and 231p/kg for two cracking red Limmies, with another 480kg British Blue to 231p/kg for "a very deserving cause". Simon Jones' 588kg model added up well to £1323, with 586kg Blues to £1277.48 from the Duddlewick stable.

39 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 162P/KG

Two cracking Limmies from Mrs Edwards once again took the headlines here at 215p/kg and 209p/kg, with 554kg Lims to 206p/kg from Katie Tomley. Harold Pugh's home bred bulls sold to 199p/kg, with an expectant Charlie Sandells (although pacing the boards) selling to 194p/kg for 576kg. Neil Preece's black and whites sold to 146p/kg.
