Too few cattle to satisfy demand, with a rip-roaring trade from start to finish and an overall average close on 260p/kg says it all! Once again, the majority of the beasts were a real credit to producers with only a sprinkling of leaner types depleting averages.

A small steer entry sold to a high of 275p/kg and £1677.50 in the lump. Finish was just as important as shape here.

Some great heifers penned today sold to 299p/kg on two occasions with 5 others 290p/kg and above. Heavy females sold past £1700 to £1769 in the lump.

Bull trade perhaps not quite as fiery as last week but still sharp with the best Continentals selling to 256p/kg or £1551 in the lump with less heavy Continentals forward today. A real go in the Holstein Friesians selling to 216p/kg with several 200p/kg and more.

#### ONLY 6 STEERS SOLD TO OV.AV. 252P/KG

Dave Roberts was a distance traveller selling to 275p/kg and 265p/kg (x2) with his Charolais' adding up nicely to £1677.50 for 610kg. Handy 502kg Lims sold to 253p/kg from Phil Corfield with Rob Foxall selling to £1600.16 for 684kg Limousin crosses.

#### ONLY 55 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 260P/KG

Richard Parkes and Mrs 'B' stole the limelight today both selling to 299p/kg for 512kg Limmies and 504kg Blues respectively. Evans (Curdale) sold their super run of red Limmies to 298p/kg for 536kg with others to 292p/kg and 291p/kg (x2). Handy 454kg Limmies for that 'deserving cause' sold to 293p/kg with her 612kg Blonde selling to £1768.68. David Preece sold his black Limmies to £1748.50 for 650kg.

#### 51 BULLS SOLD TO OV.AV. 208P/KG

Continentals topped at 256p/kg for 606kg for a red Limmie from Howard Fish with his second best selling to 246p/kg. 556kg Limousin took third spot at 238p/kg for Bill Yeomans. Black and Whites sold to 219p/kg at 498kg from Neil Beaumont with John Cantrill selling to 216p/kg.

#### DOWNTON ESTATE 13<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL STORE SHEEP SALE

On Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> August, 4022 Store and Ewe Lambs were penned for what was the 13<sup>th</sup> On Farm sale on behalf of Downton Estates. The overall quality of sheep penned would be as good or better than any of the previous sales and trade to match. The overall average was up £25 per head on last year at £88.30 with store lambs to £95 and ewe lambs to £122.

Suffolk x Mule store lambs to £95 with plenty breaking the £90 barrier with smaller long-term Suffolk's at £80 plus.

Texel x Mule lambs to £94 again with several over £90 and small long-keep Texel's to £70.

More Ram lambs than recent years with Texel's £86.50, Suffolk £75, Romney £78 and Exlana £75.

Ewe lambs showing real improvement to  $\pm 122$  for Texel x Mules although the Suffolk x Mule ewe lambs attracted more interest with clean headed but small lambs to  $\pm 120$  and 640 Suffolk sired lambs averaging  $\pm 111$ .

Smaller Texel type ewe lambs £80 to £95 depending on quality with the clean headed lambs demanding the higher prices.
