A very pleasing entry of cattle for the New Year's Eve Market. Buyers eagerly looking for cattle with few live auctions in operation this week and with low numbers forward in those that opened. Best quality cattle saw a flying trade and with most cattle selling ahead of expectation. Scottish, retail butchers and bull orders look set to return next week, so good entries will be required without fail!

Best wishes to all our farmer and buyer customers for the new decade hopefully bringing good fortune in 2020.

A very small steer entry with only one best type forward saw continentals to 214p/kg or £1,425.24 in the lump.

Our heifer show was very tidy and saw three selling to 260p/kg or more to a high of 268p/kg and to nearly £1,400 in the lump.

Bull trade was in line with recent sales and perhaps not seeing quite the lift in the clean section. Limousins sold to 200p/kg with Blues to £1,252.16 in the lump. Good fleshed Friesians sold to 165p/kg.

Despite this, a very mixed entry averaged a very respectable 203p/kg with the better sorts to 225p/kg for 42kg from Stuart Moss. Very few lambs 39kg to 43kg, the bulk of the entry lighter or the best lambs tended to be 50kg plus.

Plenty of lambs 36kg and lighter realising £2plus to 220p/kg, 36kg from Lee Preece. Only the very plain or hilly under 2p/kg, lambs around 40kg the easiest sold, most around 210p/kg and heavy weights 47kg at 220p/kg Texels and 53kg 207p/kg to a top price per head of £114 again Stuart Moss for 55kg Texels.
