More numbers today which was great to see and a firmer trade to match. We penned some superb cattle this morning which was a real credit to our producers. On a more sobering note, I don't think we can see the beef trade following the sheep trade bonanza unfortunately but every bit of help is positive.

Steer trade was well in line to recent sales with a sprinkling of better sorts. Best shapes sold to 219p/kg or £1464 in the lump.

A supersonic heifer trade saw six heifers sell to 250p/kg or more to a high of a259p/kg with heavy females selling to £1430 in the lump.

Bull trade held firm selling to 213p/kg or £1384. Holstein Friesian averages were somewhat depleted by some lean brethren but sold to 166p/kg.

10 COWS SOLD TO OV.AV. 108p/KG

It's very pleasing to see some more numbers in this section, with producers seeing the benefit of selling their culls with competition. A great trade with 640kg Blonde cows selling nicely to 133p/kg with British Blues to 124p/kg for 748kg. 982kg non-assured South Devon's to 114p/kg. 1056kg Saler stock bulls sold well to 112p/kg. Herefords to 167p/kg from Phillip Terry.

5 pens over the 300p/kg to 302p/kg from Richard Yates and Steve Perkins (twice). However, top price of 301p/kg for 49kg Texel x hoggs from Richard Morgan who has had worse days at market with his entry of hoggs averaging £146.95.

Best hoggs very hard to value pen after pen, 280p/kg plus even for weight, Simon Wadlow's 46.5kg at 294p/kg, 54kg from Peter Levi at 255p/kg and hoggs over the 50kg mark over 245p/kg, well over £125 per head.

With such a strong average you would be mistaken in thinking that every hogg was a Continental and perfect, Not So! Swales 29kg at 225p/kg, Welsh 34kg at 256p/kg and 35kg Texel x Hoggs 280p/kg.

Belly clipping is now a major talking point with hoggs quite dirty. Please ensure to make every effort to present your sheep as clean as possible. Thank you!
