Good numbers forward once again, with fair demand for beef especially in the retail sector. Best quality cattle easiest sold once again with handyweight heifers seeing the headline prices. Second quality clean cattle in need of restaurant and catering trade to get an uplift in values. These are having to meet values of Holstein bulls and cull cows to find a customer.

Some decent steers forward sold to 223p/kg or £1313.20. It is not paying to get your cattle too big as abattoirs reduce their prices on heavy carcases.

Best butchers heifers sold to a tremendous trade selling to a high of 271p/kg with others 270p/kg and 269p/kg. These handy heifers are adding up well at the moment and are coming to more than their heavy counterparts. Handy heifers sold to £1441 in the lump.

Good demand in the bull department with best continentals selling to 230p/kg or £1338 in the lump. Black and white bulls sold mostly in the 160p/kg to 167p/kg.

4 Cull cows forward met competitive bidding with Limousins selling to 147p/kg for 674kg, with young Limousins to 146p/kg.
