We are in very difficult times, unprecedented since possibly 1945 – although the various foot and mouth outbreaks did test the agricultural community to say the least, but trade today shed a shimmer of light on our farmers and buyers and what they do. Price have not been seen along these lines since the Horsegate scandal, with local butchers reporting Christmas demand or better last weekend as everybody stockpiles or buying a little extra with potential lock down imminent!

Some good quality steers forward saw best sorts selling to 242p/kg with heavies to £1554 in the lump.

Heifers were simply on fire with 250p/kg and above regularly achieved to a top of 269p/kg. Heavy heifers sold to £1453 with cattle getting dearer as the sale progressed.

The bull section started the day off on a positive note with Continentals selling to 224p/kg or nearly £1600 in the body. Friesian bulls sailed to 190p/kg with several above 180p/kg.

9 CULL COWS

A super cow trade once again saw Charolais cows to 137p/kg and 134p/kg for 974kg and 872kg respectively (£1334.38 and £1168.48). Limousin crosses sold to 124p/kg for 672kg with non-assured Angus cows to 109p/kg on two occasions.
