Good numbers this morning with a tremendous entry of meat and some real shape amongst them. A firm trade throughout with some buyers looking for few more cattle to fulfil orders. It really is paying to get your cattle fit, and fat is not necessarily a swear word.

A very useful steer entry didn't quite reach 300p/kg, to 296p/kg or a top price per head of £2018.

Some `real' heifers saw a high of 328p/kg with more than 20 heifers 300 pence or more. Heavy females sold to £1978.

Fair bull numbers saw a high of 288p/kg for continentals or £2208 in the lump, with five over £2000.

Two cows, which were non-assured, sold to 130p/kg for 714kg Hereford cross.

A tidy run of Simmentals and Limmies from John Cantrill topped at 296p/kg for 544kg with another to 288p/kg from the same stable. Dan Watkins sold his best 610kg Limousin to 295p/kg with 708kg, while Blues from 'Mrs B' added up nicely to £2017.80 at 285p/kg.

Some great handy weight Limousins from Rhys Perkins were in the limelight at 328p/kg for 496kg with his second heifer to 326p/kg for 520kg. Harvey Parkes was in second spot at 327p/kg for 482kg British Blue. Heavier Limousins from Clive Evans, Curdale sold to 322p/kg, 320p/kg and 318p/kg, with 'Mrs B' top in the headage stakes at £1978.08 for a cracking Limousin at 634p/kg.
