### 137 PRIME CATTLE

There were less cattle forward this morning with a lack lustre trade in Monday Markets not encouraging extra numbers out. Handier weight butchers cattle were easiest sold and we were fortunate to have a fair show of these. Heavier sorts would still be more than in line with the reduced deadweight quotes for this week.

No best quality steers were penned this morning with many vendors having sold out of these – the best available sold to 189p/kg or £1,220 in the whole. Best conformed butchers heifers sold to 233p/kg with several others above 210p/kg.

Bull trade was similar to last week, with 200p/kg only achieved on one occasion, with a sprinkling of other suckler bulls in the 190 pence's. Meated Friesian Holsteins sold to a high of 159p/kg.

### 2 STOCK BULLS, 1 STEER & 5 COWS SOLD TO AV. 113/KG

Plenty of customers for cows etc but most buyers couldn't start with so few forward. 908kg Limousin cows sold to 140p/kg from Tony Barker, with 656kg British Blues to 130p/kg from Brian Watkins. Shorthorn steers 4½ years old sold to 121p/kg from Ian Sadler. Blonde X stock bulls sold to 126p/kg for 1030kg for Bill Yeomans.

### 87 CLEAN CATTLE

16 steers sold to an overall average of 168p/kg. 524kg Limousins sold to 189p/kg from Stuart Ratcliffe, with two Continentals to 182p/kg both from Frank Millichamp. Simmentals sold to 176p/kg from 550kg from H Snelson & Son Ltd.

71 Heifers sold to overall average 189p/kg. 496kg British Blues topped the day for Neil Perkins at 233p/kg, with 548kg Limousins from Roger Jordin to 229p/kg. 470kg Charolais crosses sold to 228p/kg for 470kg. Second quality heifers saw improved returns.

As per recent sales, the bottom end bulls look well sold against the cream. Neil Perkins took the honours here also with his black Limousin realising 200p/kg for 628kg. Frank Povall and Matt Bower also sold over 190p/kg. Friesian bulls sold to 159p/kg from James Woolrich.
