Consistent numbers on a weekly basis at Carmarthen with a cracking trade on all grades of barrens with 10 dealers on the ringside bidding competitively for all types.

Top of £1695 for a 50-month-old Limmie cow weighing 730kg at 232.2p/kg from John Leyshon, Cefnmaes, followed at £1660 for 58-month-old Charolais cow weighing 810kg at 204.9p/kg from John, Dyllcoed Uchaf.

Top on dairy type was £1580 for A 38-month-old heifer weighing 735kg at 215p/kg from Morris, Brynawel followed at £1400 for a 64-month-old Holstein cow weighing 795kg at 179.1p/kg from CGMT LTD Madox Farm.

Top p/kg was the above 232.2p/kg, followed at 230.8p/kg from Davies, Llwynpur. Beef cows comfortably over 220p/kg and the fleshiest dairy type comfortably over 200p/kg.

It is worth nothing, there is a big demand for pre-movement tested improvers/grazers at this time of year, be it beef or dairy type barrens.

Weekly numbers still over the 200mark with a few less forward due to the long-awaited dry farming weather! Trade very sharp from start to finish, with the grazing stores looking dearer on the week!

3 tremendous 590kg Limmie bullocks from JG & MJ Howells topped the steers at £1630. Younger runs of super bullocks from TJ EE & E Davies sold to highs of £1530 with Simmie's from PM & JE Davies selling to £1520. Fleckvieh from the same home to £1490, with best of the Friesians selling at £1465 from Gail in the office! P Davies had 12-month-old Charolais bullocks at just 260kg to 338.5p/kg (£880) with 290kg Limmie's from DE & J Last selling at 334.5p/kg and £970 a head. Plenty of younger suckler bred bullocks over the 300p/kg barrier with 370kg dairy bred Blues from JW Thomas looking well sold at £1140 (310.1p/kg).

C M Currell showed another topping bred Charolais heifer which sold well at highs of £1630. TJ EE & E Davies sold 13-month-old Limmie's next at £1465, with another Limmie's from IM CA & LM Jones selling to £1395. Dairy heifers to £1360, with plenty over the £1300 mark. 310kg 12-month-old Lim heifer from RE & J Last topped the pence per kilo at 312 (£970) with dairy bred Limmie's from DJH & AE Thomas looking well sold at 306.1p/kg (320kg at £980).

Feeding bulls sold to £1210 from D Lewis for Angus, with RK Fewster selling his best Charolais bull to £1045 and 302.9p/kg.

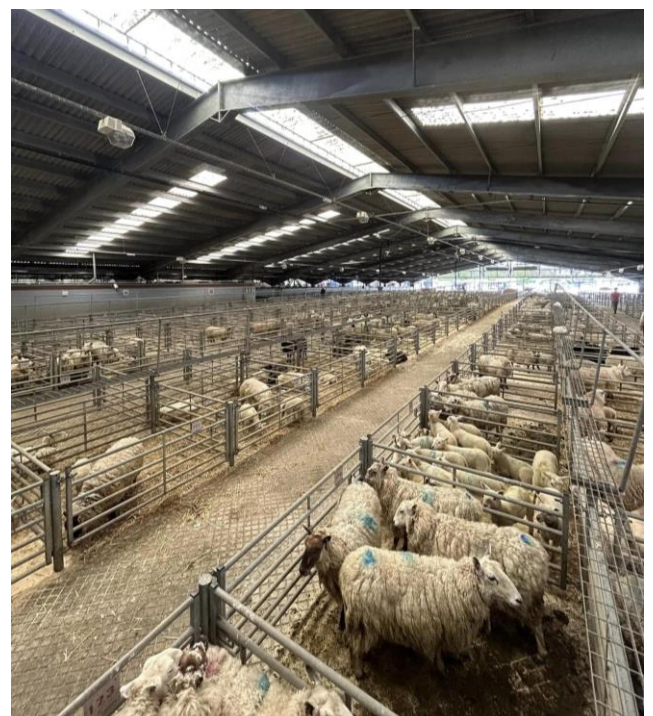
