What a start to the year with Carmarthen making a strong claim to be one of the leading markets in Wales for dairy cattle. Trade was excellent throughout where buyers came from as far as Shropshire to buy the quality we had on show.

Top of the day went to 'Fronun Altacabot America'. A very special heifer that sold for £3100 from HR Lewis who had other outstanding heifers reaching £2850 & £2800.

Selling at £2900 was 'BB Goodwhone Sara 2' a tremendous well-balanced heifer from BE Baker & Sons. 15 heifers crossed £2500 with 24 animals selling over the £2000 barrier. All freshly calved heifers levelled today at an impressive £2161.18. Dairy cows hit highs of £2320 and £2150, both from RD Law. Other 2nd calvers got to £1900 from Breeze Farm LTD with the 6 cows forward averaging £1753.33.

3 in calf heifers drew a lot of attention with all of them a month away from calving. Top spot was achieved at £1620 from Davies Bros with DG Jones getting his strongest heifer to £1520. Heifer calves were probably the most difficult to sell with current rearing costs definitely a factor. Best reared types sold to £110 from Trewern Farm LTD.

QINETIQ PENDINE RANGES
IN CARMARTHENSHIRE**



An opportunity to rent approximately 40ac/16.187ha of permanent grazing land on Pendine Ranges, within the Pendine Burrows Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI)

- As the land is subject to the Pendine Burrows SSSI grazing is subject to a maximum stocking density.
- Grazing by cattle or horses is preferred, but complimentary sheep grazing at certain times of the year will be considered
- The grazing will be available for a 7-year term, under a Licence Agreement
- Access and use will be subject to the military bylaws on Pendine Ranges
 - The winning tender will not necessarily be the highest bid, as consideration also has to be given to the suitability of the livestock grazing proposed, with more favour given to grazing by traditional extensive breeds
 - It will be advantageous if the grazer lives within one hour's driving time of the site
