Under age Charolais slips from Tucker Stoneaway selling nicely at 253p/kg for 685kg or £1733.05 in the lump. Lim cross cows from Griffiths Llanilid hit 205ppk for 661kg, with Herefords from Jones Penymaes to 203p/kg at 604kg.The few meaty cows forward were mainly dairy black and white cows and sold to 194p/kg for 556kg from Thomas Pantycoed, With heavy Holsteins, 827kg from Jones Hafod to £1554.76 in the lump.

Strong demand on all cull bulls which sold to 164p/kg for Lim cross at 752kg from Morgan Cwmper. Hereford bulls to 158p/kg and Welsh Blacks to 138p/kg.
