

CARMARTHEN LIVESTOCK MART WEEKLY REPORT – 19.10.22

A very large entry this week which included the Holstein South Wales Show & Sale. The line-up of freshly calved heifers & cows was mouth-watering and it proved to be a very tough task for the Judge of the day, Mr Tony Hack of the 'Santamaria' herd in Rhydlewsi. The morning started with the cow class which the judge awarded 1st Prize to 'Saintclear Nicola' a 2nd calver from E Thomas, Foxhole. This powerful Black cow sold to Parcyrabbot Farm Ltd for £2180. The senior heifer class was next with over 12 entries. 1st Prize went to G Williams, Penygenhill for a tremendous well-balanced heifer. 'Penrikka Dynasty Jessie' was also awarded Champion of the Day by Mr Hack and sold for £3500 to D Davies Llanllwni herd. The junior heifer class again did not disappoint, with DB & HM Jenkins & Sons, Cerrigcaranau Uchaf taking the glory with their super heifer 'Caran Fitz Enid 3'. She was also awarded Reserve Champion and sold for £2700 to the Judge at his 'Santamaria' herd. All 74 forward sold to a 100% clearance, with freshly calved heifers averaging £2092.74 and cows levelling at £1596.34.

The youngstock drew a lot of interest, especially the bulling heifers from the 'Richley' herd at Penhill Farm Ferryside. They were all sold having been genomically tested with 'Roosta Fynn Faith A' reaching highs of £1250 to R Lewis, Fronun.

The in-calf heifers were a more selected trade with only two heifers making over £1000 today. They were both from M Thomas, Blaengilfach with a Fleckvieh X in-calf to an AA bull making £1400. She sold down to Pembroke and was purchased through MartEye.

A very successful day and Nock Deighton Agricultural would like to thank Holstein South Wales club for holding their show at our mart. Thank you to Mr Tony Hack, the Judge, for doing a wonderful job and thanks also to Anwen Jones from Lallemand Animal nutrition for sponsoring the day.
