Lambs topped at £135 for heavies from Griffiths Upland Arms with others to £131 from Jones Tirbannal. A good entry from Williams Pontfaen topped at £127 with others from the same home to £117.50 and £116 for strong whitefaced sorts. Smart Charolais types from Thomas LLangynnog sold to £124 with premium certainly paid for well finished lambs. The final dance of the year wrapped things up nicely with massive thanks to the vendors and purchasers who have supported Carmarthen mart's breeding sheep sales this year. Over 4000 sheep traded throughout the sales with some real nice headlines to show for it! Friday saw another good crowd flood to Carmarthen where a massive entry of 103 rams kicked off the evening with highs of £550 for Suffolk Yearlings from Cullan Haverfordwest with others from the same home reaching £500. Texel yearlings topped at £500 from Ffynnonbrodyr and Thorne Crymych whilst Welsh yearling rams also topped at £500 from Jones Ystrad Meurig. Charolais yearlings reached £500 and £420 from Lewis Solva with plenty of people after those quality sorts from £400 up. Plenty of other breeds also saw good demand. Ewes up next with aged ewes topping the evening for 4-year-old Suffolk ewes at £192 from Owens LLety whilst Suffolk yearlings sold to £180 from Davies Nantymfen. Other continentals' yearlings sold to £168 from Gundy Spite House with 2-year-old Suffolk ewes to £162 from Waters Parclands. Mixed ages strong hill ewes from Williams Aberdwynant sold to £150 with others £140 from Williams Cae Mawr. Mostly aged ewes forward with hardly no yearlings above whilst endless pens over £120 on the night. The ewe lambs finished the successful evening with top of £202 for Dorset's from Jones Ystrad Meurig whilst blue faced ewe lambs from the same home sold to £200. Blue texel ewe lambs saw highs of £198 from Thomas Maesyrafon whilst continental types from the same home sold to £156. A strong entry of Texel x mule from Price talog maxes at £148 with the strongest whitefaced mules selling to £148 from Davies, Talley. Suffolk x mule topped at £146 from Douch with others from the same home at £145 and £141. Plenty of them strongest tupping sorts over £135 on the night with the crossbred and smaller sorts only a strong store trade in great honesty.
