Big numbers on a weekly basis in the barren ring with another flyer of a trade across the board with 13 different buyers giving the highest level of competition here every Friday!! Be it the thin type of the meaty type both were in high demand!!

Top price of £1940 for a 114-month-old Charolais cow weighing 854kg at 227.2p/kg from Thomas, Llechwedd followed at £1850 for a 77-month-old Limmie cow weighing 788kg at 234.8p/kg from Davies, Danyderi. Charolais cow from Rowlands, Llwyn Ifan Farm was next at £1840 weighing 773kg and 238p/kg.

A 55-month-old Hereford bull weighing 1015kg at 190.1p/kg topped at £1930 from Evans, Trefynys Farm. Top dairy animal was 35-month-old Holstein weighing 686kg at 234.7p/kg from Davies, Glansefin Mill.

Top p/kg was 34-month-old Limmie heifer at 301.8p/kg weighing 560kg to a lump of £1690 from Thomas, Cefnmystrych who had similar outfit at 251.7p/kg, also a 28-month-old Lim heifer at 258p/kg weighing 624kg to a lump of £1610 from Jones, Pwllisaf Farm.

Big weekly numbers and trade on a different level here on a Friday at Carmarthen. Best cattle met a fierce trade and several runs of cattle of that 350p/kg, showing the quality forward! 630kg dairy bred Blues topped the steers at £1750 from W Thomas & Co with Lim steers from DGE Jones selling next at £1730. DA AAM & DD Evans showed six stormers to highs of £1700 for 575kg. 430kg Limmie from the same home sold to £1540 and topped per kilo at 358.1p/kg. 400kg from IG & ME Jones & Co sold to £1400 or 350p/kg with all steers levelling out at just over £1250 per head this week.

Bulls topped at £2520 for a 13-month-old pedigree Charolais from CM Currell that will go on as a breeder in the locality. 15-month-old dairy bred Sim bulls sold next at £1080 from A Griffiths & G Beynon who also sold others at £880.

Limmie heifers from BDL & SM Thomas peaked at £1860 (570kg) who had another heifer selling at £1820. Blondes from E Page sold to £1700 with Charolais from DGE Jones selling to £1680. Plenty of strength over £1600 with

Despite national decrease in prime lambs prices, numbers remain steady with orders still to fill! Topping the day at £139 was James, Tanycoed whilst Lewis, Penybank sold to £136. A good entry from Griffiths, Plas y Dderwen reached £127 with Anderson, Old Railway View selling to £120. Williams, Clomendy sold their Dutch Spotted lambs to £131 with plenty of lambs over £115 on the day whilst the general run of lambs traded 275-285p/kg with highs of 291p/kg. Recent poor weather affecting numbers slightly in the prime section, and no surprise as we see more leaner lambs in the stores. Premium certainly paid for well meated lambs, more needed each week please!

863 EVENING BREEDING SHEEP SALE

Yet again another well supported evening at Carmarthen Mart as we see a quality show of breeding sheep on offer.

A phenomenal crowd travelled to Carmarthen Mart and this resulted in great demand on all sorts of sheep throughout the night. The MV section kicked off the night with an entry of Pedigree Texel yearling ewes from Thomas, Garreglwyd topping at £580 with others to £500 and £480 from the same home! A quality entry of breeding rams saw highs of £780 for a Charolais yearling from Evans, Pentrebach whilst more from the same home sold top £700 and £620. Strong Suffolk yearling rams sold to £680 and £650 twice from Griffiths, Y Bwthyn with yearling Texel rams topping at £570 from Thomas, Garreglwyd. Charolais and crossbred tups from Poulton, Plasnewydd sold to £560 with a cracking pen of Charolais yearling rams seeing highs of £560 and £550.

Commercial ewes topped at £240 for coloured Mules from Jones-Dancey, Island Farm with 2 pens of the same sorts from Jones, Tyllwyd selling to £238 and £235. Another strong pen of Mules from Jones-Dancey, Island Farm sold to £230 with Evans, Cwmsaeson's coloured Mules topping at £225 on the night. Plenty of yearlings over the £200 barrier on the night with the older ewes topping at £206 for 3-year-old Suffolks from Harding, Kidwelly. A solid entry of ewe lambs saw highs of £160 twice for Suffolk X ewe lambs from Jenkins, Cathal whilst Texel ewe lambs topped at £152 from Lewis, Llwyncelyn. A quality entry of Texel and Mule ewe lambs from Davies, Cwm Isaf sold to £150 twice with Hughes, Tynewydd's entry

reaching £145 for smart sorts! Plenty of Texels over £140 on the night whilst two pens of Radnor Mules from Jenkins, Cresselly sold to £122 which wrapped the evening up lovely. 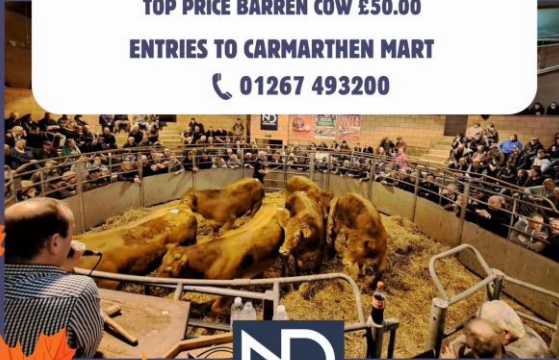
