As of 02/10/23 the rules are changing regarding selling cattle from TB restricted cattle.

If you apply for a general licence to move cattle to a red slaughter market or direct to slaughter you can also use the same licence to bring store fat and cull cattle to an orange market!

You will no longer need to apply to get an individual licence for each consignment sold.
