Wednesday was the first weekly mart of dairy cattle and calves and we could not have wished for a better start. The return of dairy cows to Carmarthen has been long awaited by both vendors and buyers and although it may take some time to get numbers back to where they were this was the beginning. Open day Champion, judged by Islwyn Gibbon, Garreg Farm, a committed customer to the mart for many years, went to Richard Lewis, Fronun with Erie Liberty Beatrix. She also took the day under the hammer, with an impressive pedigree comprising of 7 generations VG/Excellents and selling for an astounding £2750 to the judge at the Garreg. Tegwyn Jones, Pengoyallt presented a super looking Deyrn bred heifer selling at £2080 and the return of the Gest herd to Carmarthen saw Gest Haste Vanity selling at £2000. Heifers in milk averaged £1701 throughout as we look to revive the dairy section.

It was very pleasing to see the number of calves there was on this first day and we are sure that there will be more as the weeks go on. An assortment of breeds and types with the ringside full with buyers for everything.

The first calf through the ring was sold by Nigel Owens MBE and proceeds donated to the DPJ Foundation. Nigel did an excellent job, took no nonsense from the buyers, getting the very smart looking Hereford Bull calf to £1080 the first time around and £440 the second time of asking. Other leading prices saw a big Blue bull calf from Gibbon, Garreg at £400; Lim bulls from Jones, Shiral at £390 and £345; Lim bull from Rees, Neuadd Domas, Bridgend at £345. Top price heifer calf was a Lim heifer from Jones, Shiral at £420 followed by Blue heifers from Pentrefelin Farm Ltd at £340 and Evans, Croesnant at £315. Friesian bulls sold at the usual varied trade with a high of £200 from Rees, Pantllan and averaged £57 throughout. Bull calves averaged £237 and heifer calves £171 in a trade that will only get stronger as time goes on. Calves came back from near and far. Carmarthen, Fishguard, Bridgend, Lampeter, Llandysul, Llandeilo, Swansea, Llanelli just to name a few.

A short speech was conducted by Councillor Emlyn Dole to a full ring of customers and supporters around the barren ring. The Secretary of State for Wales, Mr Simon Hart was also present and our thanks go to them both for their kind words of support and their enthusiasm.

The warm words were followed by 'red hot' trade with cows getting dearer by the day.

Limousin cross cow from Morris, Stoney Ford topped the tested section at 195p/kg for 717kg with his heavier 867kg Limousin to 180p/kg or £1560.60 in the lump. British Blue cross cows from Davies, Nantclawdd sailed to 176p/kg for 616kg but the meaty Fresian was a revelation from Davies Bros, Waunllanau Isaf selling to 170p/kg for 896kg or £1523.20 in the lump, and should go a long way to replacing her.

Hereford stock bulls sold at 147p/kg for 1014kg and just short of £1500.00 from Twose Farms Ltd.

A very good entry of strong store cattle met a fast trade to a ringside filled with eager buyers. Both steers and heifers averaged over £1000 on the day with 123 cattle in all selling at four figure prices. Top price of the day was a Charolais heifer from Blakeman Farms at £1470 who also sold top price steer, a Blue, at £1460. Top quality Beef Shorthorn steers from Thomas, Llwyncelynlan sold at £1440 and £1420. Thomas, Maesrhiw sold Charolais steers at £1400 and Jenkins, Tanfforgou sold his Charolais heifers at the same money. Breed averages were also very impressive with Charolais steers averaging £1285 on the day; Charolais heifers averaged £1138; Lim heifers averaged £1134 and Hereford steers and Blue steers averaged £1047 and £1028 respectively.
