685 NEW SEASON LAMBS AVG OF 282.76p/kg

With trade being a flyer beginning of the week it was no wonder to see a good number of lambs forward. Trade today was very cautious with farms reported to have filled up with stock leading up to the Muslim festival Kurbani. To tick all the boxes this afternoon lambs had to be full of meat. Lean lambs penalised and a number of plainer lambs certainly affected the overall average.

Top end lambs 340-350p/kg with Jones, Penwern topping the day with their 50kg Texels to 352p/kg. Heavier Texels (62kg) topped the day at £178 a head. 40kg from Evans, Glyn yr Odyn sold to 340p/kg with best meated types anywhere from 300p/kg and over. Leaner lambs fell down the ladder from 270-290p/kg.
