Heifer calves topped at £330 again from Evans, Brynhogfaen, who also sold Herefords to £270. Blues from Jones, Blaencwmerwydd to £200 with a majority of the calves £120-£150. Angus and younger Blues were unfortunately less.

386 NEW SEASON LAMBS (AVG 247.32p/kg)

Few less numbers this week resulting in a very fine trade throughout. Continental types full of meat met a strong demand with local butchers present to buy the best sorts. It was great to see farmers rewarded with lambs back over the 300p/kg barrier this week. Cwrws Farm sold their 50kg Beltex to 340p/kg and topped at £170 in the lump. Jones, Penylan got his 48.50kg Texels to 336p/kg, and Thomas, Blaencwmdu topping his run of ewe lambs to 310p/kg. Plenty other top enders trading 280-300p/kg. Leaner types would be generally 230-240p/kg, with store lambs buyers present to push those types forwards.

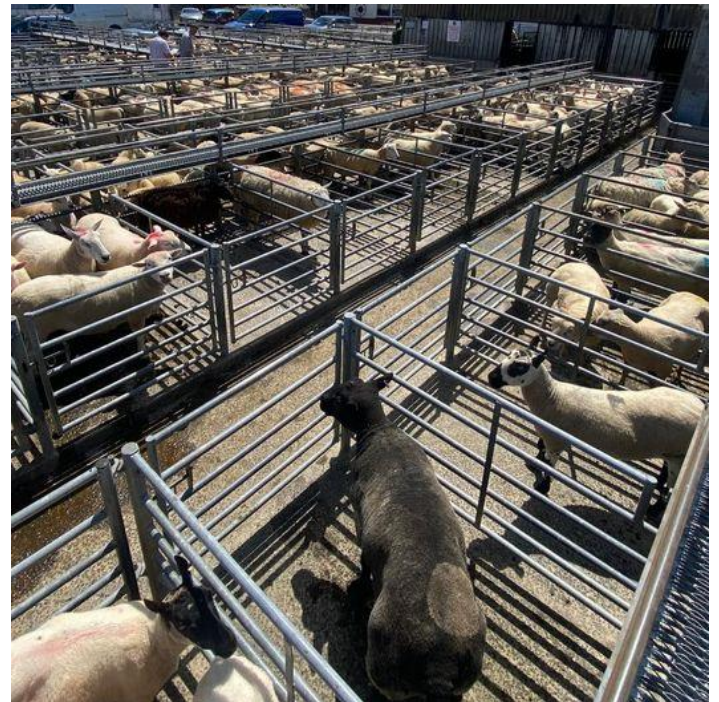
