A harder day selling prime lambs this week with big firms full to the rafters with sheep leading up to the Quabarni festival. Lambs generally 360-370p/kg with the lighter lambs (under 37kg) back to 340-350p/kg. 39kg Texels from E & S Thomas topped the trade at 385p/kg (£150), with 45's from C Reed selling to 373p/kg and £168 per head. Moving forward, the general feeling is that lamb trade will firm up as we get in to the end of the month with all festival lambs out of the way.
