16 CALVES

A good entry although many more can be traded here at Emlyn with farmers selling sheep or barrens very keen to purchase your calves and weaned calves every Thursday!! Best of the baby calves to £340 for a shapey Lim bull from E T Williams. BB's found highs of £250 with Monty x bulls from G D Evans selling to £200. A young show of native calves sold to £170 from D L , H A & G Willimas who also sold a BB heifer at £180. Top heifer of the day sold for £230 twice for a Lim and a BB from E T Williams and G D Evans respectively.

The weaned calves drew a lot of interest with a group of 7-month-old Hereford steers very well sold at £850 from R Rees. 5 heifers from I W , D W & N W Williams finished the section off with 5 month old Charolais heifers to £680 and others at £635.
