Meat was money once again with fleshy 43.5kg from EM Davies selling to 257p/kg with other 43kg from JO Evans to 251p/kg . 42kg from DJ Evans Llanio to 250p/kg with plenty over 240p/kg here this afternoon. Heavy lambs were in demand and selling generally around that 220p/kg with shapey types 225-235p/kg. Lean lambs again were harder to place anywhere either side of 200p/kg.
