Numbers holding well for the end of May with the rain over the last two weeks definitely helping the grass grow as we see more farmer buyers at the ring side today. Trade was the same story with strong, well fleshed cattle a flyer with young suckler bred sorts also well sold. Plainer dairy bred cattle harder work at times, although Friesian bullocks saw plenty of competition.

A run of pedigree and commercial suckler Lim heifers saw plenty of interest with two topping heifers from R.H. JONES selling to highs of £2150. Others from the same home to £2120.12 month old heifers to £1760 with 6 month old Limmies selling to £1020, all from RH Jones. Charolais X heifers from K Thomas sold to £1420 with 13month-old Limmie heifers from EJM & AJ Davies to £1380. DK Jones showed a wonderful run of Shorthorn cattle with the best heifers selling to £1140. Craig Rimmer continued his fine form with his Charolais X to £1120.

Hereford heifers sold to a £1050 from E & R Morris, with dairy bred Blues from C Rimmer to a £1070. D Cullen topped the steer section with his super animal reaching £1780.

Other Charolais from L. Davies to £1660. Herefords topped at £1360 from Evans Brothers with the best Limmie bullock to £1290 from D Cullen. DK Jones got his short horn steers to £1260 with Welsh black steers from DJG Lewis selling to £1100.

Plenty of steers over a £1000 with young well grown Charolais steers selling to £960.

Montbeliarde steers getting to a £1000 from AH Picton and the Blues from A L & M Robb to a £1020. Best of the Friesians selling to £825 from JO Evans.
