153 PRIME CATTLE

The shortage of cattle continues, with once again too few to satisfy our regular buying support. Although there were some good heifers forward we still had our fair share of ultra lean grassy types which would depress our overall average - hence the average below 200p/kg at 197p/kg all in.

We were very short of good steers today with a top price of 226p/kg or £1324 per head. Best heifers met strong demand selling to 269p/kg with heavy females to £1570.80. More Commercial clean cattle met strong demand.

A very mixed show of bulls which appears to be the norm for the time being. It is disappointing not to see many good bulls as these would help boost averages and line producers pockets whether selling live or dead. Continentals sold to 230p/kg or to £1450 in the lump, Friesians sold to 174p/kg with no best black & whites forward.

25 COWS SOLD TO AV. 97P/KG

Cow trade was definitely less today but still much dearer than the big boys selling on Mondays!

Howard Fish sold Limousins to 137p/kg for 798kg with another Limousin on the thick side from Gordon Ball to 127p/kg. Steaking Holsteins sold to 118p/kg from James Tudor for 782kg. Plain cows met a fair trade for the goods from 60-85p generally.

102 CLEAN CATTLE

Only 16 steers sold to average 192p/kg. Handy weight 478kg South Devons from Mr Wood sold to 226p/kg. Little Blondes 398kg sold to 214p/kg from Ray Bason. 622kg Limousins sold to 213p/kg from James Woolrich. Non fable Herefords sold to 182p/kg from Mike Smith, Holsteins to 176p/kg from Julian Aston. 30 month Limousins sold to 207p/kg (x2) for Shropshire & Jones.

86 heifers sold to average 214p/kg. A cracking run from Dave Chilton was headed by his black British Blue model selling to 269p/kg for 448kg. Dave also sold 2 Limmies to 250p/kg & 255p/kg. Richard Parkes sold Charolais' to 259p/kg & Limousins to 255p/kg for 520kg & 508kg respectively. British Blues from Jean Kirkham sold to 249p/kg for 478kg. George Morris' 524kg Limousin sold to 248p/kg, with plenty of others in the 230p/kg - 240p/kg bracket.
