## Prime Cattle Report (Red)

### 197 PRIME CATTLE

A very good entry of well-finished beasts were penned this morning and were a credit to all producers. They were well rewarded with a good trade but perhaps with the very best sorts not reaching last sale's heady heights. Our overall market average of 207p/kg reflected the strong competition, with plenty of buyers for all shapes, sizes and qualities of cattle.

Our steer entry was limited with only a sprinkling of good sorts. The best available sold to 240p/kg or £1582 on the lump. Seven heifers sold on or past 250p/kg to a high of 259p/kg, with females to £1570 as a whole. Second and third string clean cattle sold to a good trade all through.

There was some meat on the bull section also but without the very best shapes of recent weeks. Continentals sold to 236p/kg and passed 230p/kg on two occasions. Holsteins met plenty of demand once again selling to 188p/kg three times.

### 21 COWS SOLD TO AV. 128P/KG

More cows penned but nowhere near enough for the buyers! Quality was lacking but best meat Blondes at 728kg sold to 170p/kg for David Glover, with 700kg British Blues to 168p/kg for Millichamp Bros. Holsteins sold to 148p/kg again for the Glover stable.

### 123 CLEAN CATTLE

11 steers sold to average 207p/kg. Dave Chilton's useful red Limousin sold to 240p/kg at 642kg (£1540) to head this section. 638kg Limousins sold to 230p/kg from John Hammond who had his 694kg beast to total £1582.32. Non-FABBL Hereford steers to 175p/kg from Mr Smith.

112 heifers sold to average 218p/kg. A run of six from Roger Jordin & Co was headed by his British Blue cross at 259p/kg for 526kg, with a Limousin from the same home at 252p/kg. 532kg Limousins from Alice & Mike Williams took second spot at 258p/kg, with Richard Parkes selling to 257p/kg and 253p/kg for his Limmies. Steve Perkins was not outdone by much selling to 256p/kg for 470kg, with both Henry Yates and Neil Perkins achieving 250p/kg. Herefords sold to 198p/kg from Sam Jones.

## 74 YOUNG BULLS SOLD TO AV. 191P/KG

31 Holsteins etc. are included in the above average. A run of nine Continentals from Roger Tomley stole the show here at 236p/kg and 233p/kg for 606kg and 588kg respectively. Handy 414kg South Devons sold to 230p/kg from Julian Aston. 650kg Limousin from John Hewitt sold to 226p/kg, with two Lims from George Morris to 225p/kg.

Holsteins saw a sharp trade selling to 188p/kg (x2) for Glyn Breeze and the same for Rob Mayer. Others sold to 187p/kg from Graham Potter. Herefords to 214p/kg from Roger Tomley.
