## **155 PRIME CATTLE**

Despite deadweight centres dropping their quotation by yet another large slice this week, the live market saw prices holding firm with trade probably just in front of last week. Our overall average of 199p/kg reflected this with fewer best types penned.

A small entry of steers sold to 238p/kg or £1567 in the lump, with bullocks selling in front of deadweight quotations. Butchers heifers sold to 249p/kg and met a buoyant trade considering the quality forward. £1443.42 was top price heifer per head.

We required lower bull numbers this morning with customers for around 50 bulls – more bull should be needed next week with one more order back in action. Handyweight Continentals sold to 233p/kg with heavies to 221p/kg for 672kg. Meat Holsteins sold to 177p/kg.

## 19 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL

Trade was pretty fair here also despite lower demand. Shapely Continental blonde cows sold to 190p/kg for 776+kg (£1474.40), with Blue cows to 161p/kg for 692kg. Best Friesian cows sold to 137p/kg for 648kg. Foreign cows sold about 10p/kg less than a UK equivalent. Lean Simmental stock bulls to 116p/kg for 938kg.

## **113 CLEAN CATTLE**

29 steers sold to average 202p/kg. A good run of Limousins from Richard Bebb sold to 238p/kg and 236p/kg for 596kg and 620kg. John Hammond sold 670kg Limmies to 234p/kg, with Rob Jones selling to the same for 618kg. Friesian steers to 179p/kg from Mr Wood.

84 heifers sold to average 212p/kg. Richard Morgan sold his run of five to 249p/kg for 510kg, with Roy Kinnish's Blondes hitting 245p/kg for 468kg. Richard Bebb and Dave Chilton also hit 240p/kg plus. A very good trade on Hereford heifers to 187p/kg from Gordon Kennerley.

## 42 YOUNG BULLS SOLD TO AV. 185P/KG

24 bulls penned were Holstein/Friesians etc and are included in the average. A shapey Limousin from Roger Tomley sold to 233p/kg for 542kg, with Richard Bebb's 672kg Lims selling to 221p/kg.

Meat Holsteins sold to 177p/kg from Dave Glover. Overall black and white average 160p/g.

A good entry of store lambs attracted keen interest with stronger lambs £55 plus for Charollais and Texel lambs with a large percentage of the entry being smaller lean lambs which sold from £44 to £50.

Breeding ewes to a more selective trade, with stronger well-bred ewes easy to sell but plainer ewes harder work.

The annual consignment from Roger & Jill Davies sold to £157, with Suffolk yearlings averaging £152. Dave Edwards' Suffolks £121 with all Suffolks £115 plus.

One Suffolk yearling ewe, donated by Roger and Jill Davies and sold on behalf of Cancer Research, realised £375 being purchased by Oliver Clack for £150 and resold for £225 to Guy Needham.
