A good entry filled with quality cattle and steers in particular were in high demand this week. Top 50 steers sold from £1000 up to top price of the day which was £1550 for a cracking 22 month Lim steer from Davies, Fferm Pantyffynnon. Pantyffynnon presented some well confirmed cattle averaging an impressive £1400 throughout. There were some younger cattle also on offer with steers up to 12 months selling to £1005 and averaging £833. Continental cattle probably fetched the most eye-catching prices on the day with Lim steers averaging £1196 throughout, Charolais averaged £1171 and Blues £1058. But the native breeds weren't shabby at all with Angus steers from John, Dyllcoed Uchaf selling at £1220 and Hereford heifers from Mark Dennard selling at £1170. 33 CULL COWS / OTMS

After an excellent trade numbers were surprisingly down on the previous week but trade keeps going upwards. Topping the day's trade was a fleshy Charolais cow from Williams, Penralltfangor. Weighing 776kg she sold at 219ppk realising £1699.44. Jones, Brynmeini sold two topping cows well with his Sim cow coming back to £1383.90 at 210ppk and Hereford cow to £1335.29 at 199ppk. The better graded dairy cows also sold well.

A ten year old Holstein cow from Jones, Brynmaen sold at 175ppk and £1239 while black and white cows from Thomas, Hafodwen and Blaenpant Farms also returned four figure prices at 161ppk and 157ppk respectively. Cows averaged 166ppk on the day and over the £1000/head throughout.
