Prime Cattle Report (Red)

182 PRIME CATTLE

An improved number of clean cattle were penned this morning, with a few more better quality sorts forward. Another very good trade resulted with an overall average of 203p/kg including over agers and ultra-lean types. It is amazing that with barley at £128/tonne there were cattle in a red market with no finish and plenty of time to go. These sorts did not help the average figure.

Only a handful of steers saw the best selling to 237p/kg or £1493.88 – there were no best heavy bullocks forward. A sharp heifer trade without the heady heights of last week's bonanza – the best selling to 260p/kg and passed 250p/kg on either other occasions.

A depleted bull entry saw the best Continentals selling to 229p/kg, with heavies lumping up to £1535.60. Trade on black and whites was good if they were well-finished and consequently two square Friesians sold to 208p/kg and another to 219p/kg.

34 COWS & 5 STOCK BULLS SOLD TO AV. 134P/KG

Another useful trade here but without any best cows forward. Young British Blue cows sold to 195p/kg for 686kg (£1337) from George Morris, with another to 174p/kg. Rob Morris sold Blues to 165p/kg also. 922kg Holsteins sold to £1235.48 from James Tudor. A good trade on the plainer end, as many were above 600kg and more saleable.

1004kg Blue stock bulls sold to 149p/kg from Neil Perkins, with Harold Pugh's Limousin to 140p/kg for 982kg.

128 CLEAN CATTLE

Only 21 steers sold to average 213p/kg. 572kg and 624kg Limousins from James Woolrich both sold to 237p/kg. 620kg and 590kg Limousins from Stuart Bebb both hit 230p/kg. 708kg Limousins sold to £1493.88 from Shropshire & Jones. Hereford cross steers sold to 195p/kg again from the Woolrich stable.

107 heifers sold to average 212p/kg. Steve Perkins took the honours here at 260p/kg for 474kg, with George Morris closely following with his 516kg and 488kg models to 256p/kg and 258p/kg. Richard Parkes' super run sold to 256p/kg on two occasions. Jean Kirkham sold to 250p/kg and 254p/kg, with Andrew Dalton and Rob Morris also achieving 250p/kg. Angus heifers sold to 197p/kg for Bob Mayer.

54 YOUNG BULLS SOLD TO AV. 180P/KG

29 Ayrshires, Holsteins and Friesians etc are included in today's entry. Two super bulls from Neil Preece sold to 229p/kg and 3220p/kg for 576kg and 698kg (£1535) respectively. 506kg Lims sold to 227p/kg from Brian Link. 530kg Friesians from Mary Beaumont sold to 219p/kg. Other Friesians from Dave Evans both sold to 208p/kg.
