119 PRIME CATTLE

If this was a three word Tuesday, all we could say is "A Fantastic Trade". Too few cattle to satisfy regular orders with every buyer leaving short of beasts. With quality cattle very thin on the ground and the worst show of bulls for many a day; we averaged 206p/kg on everything.

A supersonic clean trade saw steers selling to 257p/kg and £1694 in the lump. Heifers sold regularly over 250p/kg to a high of 273p/kg with three others 260p/kg plus. Second quality heifers and steers were as dear as they have been for a while.

Bull trade was good but a very mixed show did not help the cause! Best available sorts sold to 220p/kg with Holsteins to 186p/kg. Bulls that are too old or lean were not really required.

34 COWS SOLD TO AV. 100P/KG

There were many plain steaking and boning cows forward and these met similar returns to recent sales. Many of these were below 500kg – Jerseys, New Zealand types etc. Few meat cows forward sold to 153p/kg for 866kg (£1324.98). Friesian Holsteins sold to 132p/kg and 130p/kg (x2).

13 steers sold to an overall average of 213p/kg. Limousin steers from Neale Dalton sold to 257p/kg for 566kg to head the section with his 706kg bullock achieving 240p/kg (£1694.60). 586kg British Blues sold to 235p/kg from David Chilton. Hereford steers to 221p/kg from Ray Bason.

73 heifers sold to average 220p/kg. A run of five sweet heifers from Richard Parkes headlined at 273p/kg for 488kg, with two others to 260p/kg. Dave Chilton's Limousin at 488kg sold to 261p/kg. Ray Bason sold to 258p/kg and 259p/kg for 530kg and 532kg respectively. Richard Hartley sold to 256p/kg for 504kg. Heavy 640kg Lims from David Preece sold to 256p/kg (£1638.40).
