## Prime Cattle Report (Red)

### 178 PRIME CATTLE

More cattle forward this morning met blistering demand, with all shapes and sizes at least as dear as last week's 'flier'! All cattle including bulls sold to average 212p/kg. A ring full of buyers produced some serious competition throughout the sale with cattle as dear at lot one to the end.

A small consignment of 28 steers sold to a high of 260p/kg on two occasions for cattle below 600kg. There were few best bullocks over 700kg entered and these sold to £1614.60 for Charolais. Heifers met a supersonic trade with butchers and wholesalers short of product- butchers beasts sold to 270p/kg and passed 265p/kg on two occasions, with eight other 250p/kg or above.

Although bull trade is not as dear as the clean, there was more 'bite' here today, with well-finished cattle easiest sold. Continentals topped at 235p/kg, with Holsteins a very tidy trade to 192p/kg.

### 7 COWS OV. AV. 118P/KG

Not enough cows to satisfy our four regular men - a very good trade with 974kg Charolais to £1577.88 for Richard Pugh at 162p/kg. Meat Holsteins sold to 143p/kg from Gary Shropshire, with Herefords to 133p/kg from Phil Clarke.

### **MORE COWS URGENTLY REQUIRED**

### 113 CLEAN CATTLE

Only 28 steers sold to average 213p/kg. Three cracking Limousins from LH Wardle took all the honours at 260p/kg (x2) and 259p/kg for 552kg to 574kg. 662kg Limousin sold to 239p/kg from John Hammond. Charolais 702kg from Vincent Evans hit £1614.60, with Mr Terry's Limousin crosses to £1600.80 for 690kg. Thick meat Limousins sold to 238p/kg from David Bayliss. Small Welsh Blacks to 213p/kg for Julian Aston.

85 heifers sold to average 223p/kg. 492kg Limousins from Steve Perkins sold to 270p/kg to hit the headlines with five Continentals from Richard Parkes selling to 259p/kg, 266p/kg (x2), 257p/kg and 254p/kg. Limousins from Dave Chilton flew to 258p/kg with Simon Jones selling to 254p/kg for 546kg. Neale Dalton and Peter Raybould also sold above 250p/kg. Herefords sold to 207p/kg from Richard Wilkes, with Friesians to 164p/kg from Mark McCall.

There were several cattle over 30 months and also over 36 months included in the clean averages.

## 65 YOUNG BULLS SOLD TO AV. 199P/KG

21 Holsteins etc. are included in the above average. A superb run from Duddlewick once again saw Lims and Blues selling to 235p/kg, 233p/kg and 230p/kg for cattle to 632kg. Handy Blondes from Brian Watkins sold to 227p/kg for 494kg. British Blues sold to 225p/kg for two from John Amphlett.

Holsteins with meat saw a good trade once again selling to 192p/kg from Dave Glover, with heavier black and whites to 187p/kg from Bob Mayer.
